Latin name: Hibiscus rosa sinensis Family: Malvaceae

Regional names: असूध (Gujarati), जासुद (Hindi)

Morphology: Shrub. Leaves: Simple, alternate, petiolate, serrate margin and acute tip with Ovate-ovate lanceolate shape. Flower: Corolla is tubular below, scarlet red, complete. Fruit is in capsule, obortive. Seeds are endospermic.
