AGASTYA



Latin name: *Sesbania grandiflora*

Family: Fabaceae

Regional names: અગાથિઓ, અગત્સ્ય (Gujarati), अगस्त्य(Hindi)

Morphology: Tall, slender tree, Leaves: 15 to 30 cm. long, compound, leaflets are 16 to 30 pairs, Flower: White in colour, 2 to 4 flowers in one cluster, Fruit: Pod upto 50 cm. long

Synonyms: Vangsena, Vakrapushpa, Munipushpa, Vranari, Munidruma

Rasa: Tikta

Guna: Laghu, Ruksha

Virya: Sita

Vipaka: Katu

Karma: Kapha - Pitta shamaka, Netrarogahara, Kasahara, Varnya

Useful parts: Panchanga

Indications: Netraroga, Kasa, Sula, Pandu, Pliharoga

Dosage: Kwatha – 50-60 ml., Swarasa– 10 – 20 ml

Formulations: Grahanikapata rasa, Pittakasantaka Rasa.
