Latin name: Saraca asoka/ Saraca indica

Family: Caesalpinaceae

Regional names: અશોક (Gujarati), अशोक (Hindi)

Morphology: A small evergreen tree, bark is dark brown to grey. Leaves: oblong-lanceolate.

Flowers: Red, fragrant in dense axillary corymbs. Pods are black. Seeds :4-8

Synonyms: Tamrapallava, Kankeli, Gandhapushpa, Hemapushpa, Pindapushpa, Madhupushpa,

Virya: Sheeta Vipaka: Katu

Karma: Kapha-Pittahara, Hrudya

Useful parts: Bark

Indications: Asrugdara, Apachi, Daha, Raktadosha, Shotha

Dosage: 20-30g for the decoction

Formulations: Ashokarishta, Ashoka ghruta
